

## Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6)



In Years 3-6, children prepare for KS2 SATS, as well as entry into independent colleges. Their day starts at 8:30am with lessons through until 3:30pm. Sports coaching takes place for an hour four days a week following lessons. After a snack, children are supervised whilst reading books chosen from the refurbished school library and completing their set prep. The day ends at 5.30pm.

A full curriculum is followed in Key Stage 2. The core subjects of English, mathematics and science are supported by history, geography, scripture, I.C.T., music, art, P.E. and French (from Year 4). Science is taught in a well-equipped laboratory and I.C.T. in a computer suite, with a local area network of sixteen PCs, one for each pupil.



Activities take place one afternoon per week and include surfing, judo, horse riding, sports skills, golf, art, cookery, pottery, chess, canoeing and Canadian kayaking.

St Petroc's also offers Saturday morning activities. These have proved so popular that 90% of our children regularly choose to attend. They do not have to wear uniform and the morning is devoted to activities such as drama, sport, etc.



At the end of Key Stage 2, the majority of pupils will have won scholarships to other independent schools, including Harrow School, Blundell's School, Kelly College, Edgehill College, St Joseph's School, Shebbear College and West Buckland School, to name but a few.
